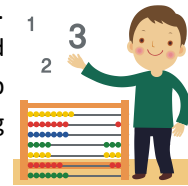

English –

This term the text type we will be focusing on is Exposition (ie a persuasive text). We will look at the type of language and the structure used when writing a persuasive text, in particular Exposition. In reading we will be developing children’s automatic use of reading comprehension strategies. The children have been tested to determine appropriate reading material. Throughout the term children will be planning and delivering short oral presentations on set topics. This will develop active listening behaviours, and confidence in speaking appropriately to an audience. We will continue using the Oxford word list to further develop our reading / writing skills.

Maths – Number and Algebra, Measurement

In Mathematics, children will be consolidating their understanding of numbers to 100. Children will continue to participate in mental routines, problematised situations and reflections. Children will be using variety of number strategies e.g. rainbow facts, skip counting, doubles, near doubles and counting on and back. We will be investigating Measurement - length, time and capacity, using uniform informal units.



Health – Relationships

Children will explore a range of relationships and know that relationships can change. They will be identifying a network of people they can trust: people who are close to me, people who are important to me, people who are not close, and people I don’t know.

Humanities and Social Science -

Children will be developing their understanding of different family structures and how these have changed over time, comparing this to their own lives.

In Geography, we will be focusing on the natural, managed and constructed features of familiar places.

Design and Technology –

This term our Design and Technology will be integrated with Health and HASS. We will be designing, making and appraising objects, using a variety of skills.



Science– Biological Sciences

Students will be observing and investigating the features and behaviours of small animals.
