Welcome back term 4!

After a well deserved break it's good to be back to an exciting and fun loaded term 4. This term we have a range of school and class based events and activities happening including Sports Day and our End of Year concert (more information to come). We look forward to these fun events and continue to be a part of your child's learning.

### English

This term the students will be continuing to practice the following text types: Recounts, and Procedure. We will be looking closely at the structure, of grammar and writing features of these text types. We will also be continuing Jolly Phonics and Grammar, Handwriting and Oral Language as part of our learning in English. Guided reading programs focusing on a variety of reading comprehension strategies will also continue throughout this term.

### Science

The topic for this term is 'Chemical Science'- We will be investigating different materials can be combined for a particular purpose.

### Mathematics

This term we will continue to develop our number knowledge understand and skills with numbers to 1000. We will focus on and revise addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Students will learn about reading and using time including half past, quarter past and quarter to the hour. We will continue to investigate fractions of objects and groups with a focus on half, quarters, and eights. We will also be looking at Chance and Data concepts as well as collecting data to display it on lists tables and graphs.

### History

In History the Year 2 Historical Knowledge Is based on the theme "The Past in the Present". We will continue learning about the impact of changing technology on people's lives at home and in the ways they worked, travelled, communicated, and played in the past. The students will be learning to create timelines by sequencing events in order using a range of terms relevant to the topic. We will also be looking at a Famous person like Sir Douglas Mawson and his contribution to our local history.
