Overview 2021

Welcome back to term 3!

We hope you all had an enjoyable break with your child. After beginning the term learning online we are pleased to be back at school in week 2. This term we are looking forward to our Japanese Cultural Day at the end of the term and all of our exciting learning before then.

English

This term we will be focusing on the structure, grammar and writing features of Explanation texts and Information Reports.

During Jolly Spelling and Grammar, students will develop their understanding of sentences as we explore proofreading, expanding sentences and conjunctions.

Guided reading programs focusing on a variety of reading comprehension strategies, Handwriting and Oral Language will continue as part of our learning in English.

History

In History the Year 2 Historical Knowledge is based on the theme “The Past in the Present”. We will be learning about the impact of changing technologies on people’s lives. The students will be learning to create timelines by sequencing events in order using a range of terms relevant to the topic. We will also be looking at local history.

Mathematics

This term we will continue to develop our number knowledge with numbers to 1000. We will connect our number, addition and subtraction skills during our unit on Money. Students will focus on recognising and ordering notes and coins according to their value,

In measurement we will explore capacity and weight using uniform informal units. We will interpret simple maps discussing the position of key features.

Integrated with our science unit we will ask questions to collect meaningful data and develop our skills to represent and display data.

Science

Earth and Space Science -

We are exploring how the Earth’s resources are used in a variety of ways. Focusing on natural resources with a particular focus on water conservation and the water cycle.

PE/Health, Japanese, The Arts

Specialist providers Michael, Des, Erin Lauren and Abby are covering these subjects. You can read about their programs in their specialist newsletters accessed via the school website.

Health

The PE/Health teachers Michael and Des will cover health. Class teachers will be teaching the Child Protection Curriculum component. This term we will discuss early warning signs and how they help keep ourselves safe. We will reconnect with our learning about trust networks and distinguishing between safe people to go to for help.

STEM

(Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths)

We will be integrating STEM throughout all aspects of the curriculum this term. We welcomed a new set of 30 laptops last term which we will continue to utilise to support our learning.
