This term the students will be continuing to practice the following text types: Information Reports, Recounts, and Procedures. We will be looking closely at the structure, grammar, and writing features of these text types. We will also be continuing Jolly Phonics and Grammar, Handwriting and Oral Language as part of our learning in English. Guided reading programs focusing on a variety of reading comprehension strategies will also continue throughout this term.
