

# E4 | Term 4 Overview 2022



Welcome to term 4!

We hope the children have thoroughly enjoyed our swimming start to Term 4.



## English

This term the students will be focusing on the following text types: Recounts, Procedures and Narratives. We will be looking closely at the structure, grammar and writing features of these text types. We will use our experiences in other curriculum areas (Science, Geography and Technology) to write recounts and procedures that the children have taken part in to deepen their understanding of these text types. We will also be continuing Jolly Phonics and Grammar, Handwriting and Oral Language as part of our learning in English. Guided reading programs will focus on a variety of reading comprehension strategies.

## Science

The topic for this term is chemical sciences. Students will build on their understanding of the properties of materials to explore how they can be physically changed.

## Mathematics



This term we will continue to develop our number knowledge with numbers up to and beyond 100 with a particular focus on consolidating skip counting by 2s, 5s and 10s. We will look at problem solving to further demonstrate our understanding of subtraction and addition. The children will explore Australian coins and compare them to coins from other countries. We will also continue looking at place value, playing the 'One, Tens, Hundreds' game.

## HASS

**Geography**— Students will be learning about the features of local places. They will learn about natural and man made features in our local area.
