English

Phonemic Awareness

- 'Heggerty' curriculum

Reading/Phonics

- Jolly Phonics Program – explicit teaching of digraphs and associated spelling rules
- Tricky Words- practise reading and spelling for fluency
- Comprehension Strategies
- Decoding Strategies
- Development of reading stamina

Writing

- Bookmaking
- Application of Phonics knowledge/spelling rules
- Handwriting (letter formation)
- Tricky Words
- Sentence structure
- Grammar – nouns, verbs and adjectives
- Text Structures- procedure and explanation

Mathematics

Number and Place Value

- Continued work on counting to and from 100, starting from any point
- Understand and use the rules for creating and reading two and three digit numerals
- Understand partitioning of numerals and the importance of grouping in tens
- Understand that two digit numerals are comprised of tens and ones

Fractions

- Understand that fractions are equal parts of a whole
- Share a collection of materials into two equal parts/portions
- Split an object into two equal pieces and describe how the pieces are equal

- Identify outcomes of familiar events involving chance and describe them using everyday language such as 'will happen', 'won't happen' or 'might happen'
