### MORNING ROUTINE

School begins at 8:40am and the classroom will open for the children to come inside and organise themselves for the day. Children will need to leave their school bag in their locker and bring their blue bag, lunch box, drink bottle and hat into the classroom.

#### **In the classroom children will need to:**

- Place their lunchbox in their tray.
- Place their hat in their tray.
- Place their water bottle on the designated table.
- Place their BEE (Bring Everything Everyday) pouch, notes home pouch and blue bag in the designated boxes or trays.
- Then, sit on the carpet ready for the roll.

*Please encourage your child to unpack their own belongings independently as this is a valuable skill for them to acquire.*

For the first few days of school we will begin each day with play based learning experiences to support children's transition.

### END OF THE DAY

School finishes at 3pm and your child will meet you outside our classroom in the Red Courtyard. Please advise me if you have any alternative pick up arrangements, e.g. OSHC.
