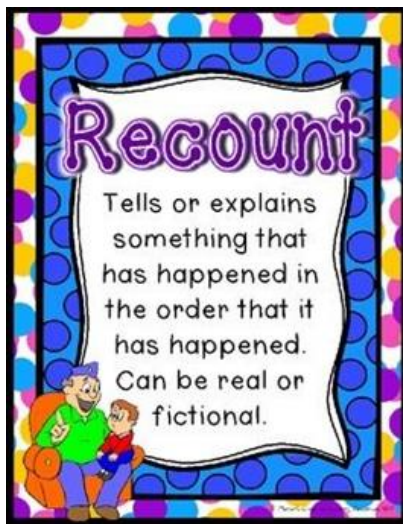

Writing A Procedure



A poem:

- sometimes rhymes and sometimes doesn't.

Poetry can be written for many purposes, including to:

- tell a story
- deliver a message
- describe feelings
- describe a person, place, event.
