TERM 3 OVERVIEW 2024

Welcome to Reception! We hope you all have settled in nicely. Over the first two weeks children have been becoming familiar with the school environment and classroom routines. We have enjoyed getting to know all the mid year students and welcoming them into our classes. We have an exciting term ahead of us and look forward to seeing the students learn and grow.

ENGLISH

Children have begun their learning in the Phonological Awareness program which focuses on listening, rhyme, syllables, blending and segmenting. Through a range of whole class and small group opportunities children will develop these skills in the heggerty program and guided reading groups. Children will also explore these skills as they begin their learning in the Literacy Gurantee Unit phonics program. Our text type focus for this term will be Narrative. Children will have the opportunity to become authors and develop their understanding of concepts of print and conventions of writing.

SCIENCE

Our focus for this term is Chemical Science. Children will recognise that objects can be composed of different materials and how to describe the observable properties of these materials.

HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SCIENCE

In HASS we are focusing on History this term we will be looking at people in our family and where they are born and raised.

TECHNOLOGIES

Digital and Design Technologies is integrated throughout many learning experiences. Children have opportunities to engage with the interactive board, use scissors and explore technologies when making.

MATHEMATICS

Our maths topic for this term will be exploring counting and with a focus on the numerals 0-10. Children will engage in a range of number-sense activities, writing digits, matching symbols and discovering the rules for counting a collection.

CHILD PROTECTION CURRICULUM

Children will be exploring the Zones of Regulation and identifying what emotions they feel in the different zones. The topic for CPC this term is 'The right to be safe'. Children will explore skills to identify safe and unsafe situations, warning signs and risk taking.
