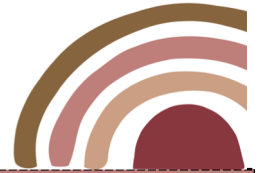


Reception

Welcome back to Term 4!

It is hard to believe the end of year is almost here. We hope you are all rested and ready for a busy and quick term!

ENGLISH

In English this term we will revise many concepts, strategies and skills that we have learnt over the year. It is an opportunity for the students to really show what they know in their literacy development. This includes Phonological Awareness skills to support children in their writing and reading development.

Our multisensory phonics activities will be continued by the children's own classroom teacher this term. As we focus on each individual's needs.

Children will participate in shared and guided reading experiences through a range of individual and collaborative tasks. With decoding and checking for understanding as the main concepts taught within these sessions.

Our text type focus for this term is 'procedure', we will also revise our knowledge of recount, as we have many events this term to use as inspiration within our writing.

Tricky words will be tested and take home books will continue as per your child's class routine.

MATHEMATICS

In mathematics we will continue to revise our work with numbers 0 – 20 (recognizing, naming, ordering). We will consolidate our learning of the rules for reading and writing digits, matching symbols and quantities and the rules for counting a collection.

Children will begin to investigate 'data' this term, as they answer yes/no questions to collect information and inferences.

CHILD PROTECTION CURRICULUM

The topic this term is practicing Protective Strategies, children are given the opportunity to learn how to use the phone correctly, know their personal details and understand with whom they can share this information with.

HUMANITIES & SOCIAL SCIENCES

Our theme for History and Geography this term is 'Celebrations', investigating the different celebrations and cultural traditions from around the world.



SCIENCE

In Science this year, children will be exploring the strands of Chemical, Biological, Earth and Space, and Physical Sciences. Children will engage in a range of inquiry, guided investigations and play based experiences to deepen their knowledge of the content linked to each strand. Through the year children will learn about the weather, living things the observable properties of objects and the way objects move.

TECHNOLOGIES

Digital and Design technologies are integrated throughout learning experiences across all areas. Children will have frequent opportunities to engage with various tools in design experiences and through playful learning.
