HEALTH and PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Curriculum:

In Health and Physical Education this term we will continue to focus on the following - Active play and minor games

- Fundamental movement skills
- Lifelong physical activities
- Healthy benefits of physical activity
- Mental Health and wellbeing

Primary students have begun a unit of work called "Dribblers" where the concepts of ball control and movement are the key elements. Small sided Basketball, Netball and Tag style games are being used to maximize individual participation.

Junior Primary students will continue to participate in Minor Games, allowing them to develop their fundamental movement skills. They are also working on a variety of activities where the foundations of ball skills will be taught. This includes rolling, trapping, under arm throws and catching.
