

TERM OVERVIEW

Term 4 in The Arts

We will be continuing our learning of Music in term 4. Students will extend their knowledge of the elements of music through a variety of activities and projects. Below is a more detailed description of what each year level will be learning.

R-2 - Students will continue to become aware of rhythm, pitch, dynamics and expression, form and structure. They will explore sounds as they listen and make music. Students will learn how to move and perform with the beat and tempo. They will develop their aural skills by using voice and movement to explore rhythmic patterns and pitch. Through a trial-and-error-experience students will put ideas into action and participate in rhymes, songs and readiness activities.

3 -4 - Students will continue to develop listening skills to recognise high and low pitch, rhythm, loud and soft dynamics and fast and slow tempo. They will explore standard notation and learn the notes of the treble stave and how they work together to create rhythms and melodies. Through this, they will learn to improvise and trial ideas to create compositions.

5 -6 - Students will continue to explore ways of combining the elements of music through creating both digital and traditional sounds to communicate ideas. Students will improvise and organise ways of combining elements of music and use correct musical terminology when rehearsing and refining improvisations and compositions. Students will demonstrate how combinations of sounds and elements communicate a musical idea to an audience. They will present performances using digital technologies to record and perform musical ideas.
