THE ARTS

Term 2023

Reception - Year 2

Students will continue to explore and talk about the visual arts elements of line, colour and shape. Students will create artworks through drawing and constructing with a variety of materials. Through this they will draw images and make objects relating to themselves, using imagination, past, experiences and ideas to inform the creation of their artwork. Students will share their artworks using some known visual arts terminology.

Years 3 - 4:

Students will explore meaning and interpretation, and forms and elements including structure, intent, character, settings, composition, time, space and sound as they make and respond to media artworks. Students will be creating a stop motion animation about what makes them unique, discussing the ethical behaviour of individuals when producing media artworks for a variety of audiences and recognise appropriate and inappropriate use of other people's images and work in the making of media artworks.

Years 5-6:

Students will develop their use of structure, intent, character and settings by incorporating points of view and genre conventions in their compositions. Extend their understanding and use of time, space, sound, movement, lighting and technologies through creating an iMovie that captures emotions through silhouettes. Students will explain the purpose and processes for producing media artworks and consider the ethical behaviour and role of communities and organisations in regulating access to media artworks.
