Term 3 2023

Reception - Year 2

Term 3 junior primary students will be focussing on drama. Students will explore purposeful and imaginative role play through imitating characters while practising dramatic play. Reception students will explore sounds and movements to establish the setting and role of the drama. Year 1 & 2 students will take on possible roles of known characters in imaginary events. They will also work individually and in pairs to participate in imaginary play, improvisation and guided drama to dramatise problems and resolutions.

Years 3 - 4:

In term 3 year 3 & 4 will be exploring music. Students will develop listening skills to recognise high and low pitch, rhythm, loud and soft dynamics and fast and slow tempo. They will consider meaning and intention when listening to music along with responding to and respecting others as performers and audience members. Students will recognise and describe how the elements of music are combined to communicate ideas and meaning. They will extend learned rhythms and melodies through improvisation and trial ideas to create compositions.

Years 5-6:

In term 3 year 5 & 6 students will explore ways combining the elements of music through creating both digital and traditional sounds to communicate ideas. Students will improvise and organise ways of combining elements of music and use correct musical terminology when rehearsing and refining improvisations and compositions. Students will demonstrate how combinations of sounds and elements communicate a musical idea to an audience. They will present performances using digital technologies to record and perform musical ideas.
