Reception - Year 2

Term 3 junior primary students will continue to focus on drama. Through imaginative role play and imitating, characters, students will perform a puppet show with puppets and characters they create. Through this, reception students will explore sounds and movements to establish the setting and role of the drama. Year 1 & 2 students will take on possible roles of known characters in imaginary events.

Years 3 - 4:

In term 4, year 3 & 4 will continue to explore music. Students will proceed with their understanding of the musical elements of time and duration, pitch, timbre, form and structure, texture, dynamics and expression. They will consider meaning and intention when listening to music along with responding to and respecting others as performers and audience members. Through our unit of work A Trip To The Stars, students will recognise and describe how the elements of music are combined to communicate ideas and meaning.

Years 5-6:

In term 4 year 5 & 6 students will continue to explore ways combining the elements of music through creating both digital and traditional sounds to communicate ideas. They will be doing this by creating a soundscape and musical themes for characters they create. Students will organise ways of combining elements of music and use musical terminology when rehearsing and refining improvisations and compositions. Students will demonstrate how combinations of sounds and elements communicate a musical idea to an audience.
