W12 Term Overview

Welcome to Term 3, I hope you all had a relaxing holiday. We are looking forward to a successful term of learning.

English

We will continue to focus on Jolly Grammar Spelling, expanding our vocabulary and dictation. We are continuing our differentiated spelling groups with the other year 4/5/6 classes.

Our writing focus for the term will be procedure and explanation writing whilst continuing to focus on grammar and punctuation within these texts.

Oral language is included in our weekly program to provide students with opportunities to express their thoughts and ideas about their learning as well as presenting work to the class. This will be through dialogic discussions and daily maths chats.

Guided Reading will continue to be a part of our daily program where the students will focus on developing their reading and comprehension skills. It is encouraged that students spend some time reading at home with someone and they try to discuss and deconstruct the texts they have read. This will really support them with building excellent reading comprehension skills.

Mathematics

This term we will be continuing to do the Daily Maths Chats where students practice recall of a number of skills they have learnt throughout the year and previously. We will also continue to focus on Number and Place value and problem solving embedded in all other areas of the mathematics curriculum. Our main focus areas for the term will be shape and geometric reasoning and financial maths.

HASS

This term the focus will be on geography. The students will be learning about the importance of environments, including natural vegetation, to animals and people and the impact of bushfires or floods on environments and communities, and how people can respond.

Science

To link with our learning in geography we will be exploring Earth and Space science, with a focus on how the Earth's surface changes over time as a result of natural processes and human activity and learning that the Earth is part of a system of planets orbiting around a star (the sun).

Technologies

The focus this term will continue to be design and technologies also linking in with science and geography where the student will investigate the suitability of materials, systems, components, tools and equipment for a range of purposes such as fire retardants and waterproof items and flood barriers.
