### Welcome Back!

We hope you had lovely break with your families. We look forward to a fun term of learning as well as events including Aquatics Day, Market Day, the Colour Run and Grandparents and Special Visitors Day.

### English

In English, we will continue to develop students reading comprehension through a routine guided reading program, where students read with teacher in small, guided groups at least once a week. Students will develop their writing skills through the Explanation and Information Report text types.

We will continue to build on students' speaking and listening skills through class discussions, sharing work samples and group work. The delivery of spelling during term 3 will remain the same, with the Jolly Spelling program offered by various teachers at the same routine time. One spelling list is provided over a fortnight period. Grammar is included in the Jolly Program, complementing the spelling lists.

### Mathematics

In Mathematics with Wenwen, W32 will strengthen their financial literacy understanding, investigating the use of money and in real-life scenarios in preparation for Market Day. In order to apply discounts and conduct transactions successfully, they will solve problems involving the four operations of related decimals and percentages.

In Mathematics with Beata, W32 will focus on Measurement and Geometry. Students will solve problems using the properties of angles. They will interpret and compare a variety of data displays including those displays for two categorical variables and students will locate an ordered pair in any one of the four quadrants on the Cartesian plane.

We will continue our daily focus selecting and applying efficient mental and written strategies to solve realistic problems using fluency, problem solving and reasoning.

### Child Protection Curriculum

In Term 3, students will develop their understanding of different types of abuse, including online abuse. They will discuss strategies and avenues of recognizing and reporting abuse.

### Homework

In term 3 students will receive their homework chart and a homework diary for the term. They will pick their own tasks from Mondays to Thursdays.

### Humanities and Social Studies

Students will explore Economics and Business in term 3. They will develop skills in identifying the effect that consumer and financial decisions can have on the individual, the broader community and the environment as well as the reasons businesses exist to provide goods and services. Students will propose and design a stall, make the products, promote the business and sell their goods for profit on Market Day.



### Science

Our focus in term two will be Biology. We will explore growth and survival of living things and how they are affected by physical conditions of their environment and physical conditions.

### Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM)

Our STEM activities are integrated across the curriculum. The students will develop their problem-solving skills through designing, making, modifying and appraising depending on the student's interests and inquiry questions about the given topic.

In Digital Technology students will investigate coding through programs such as Scratch and Makers Empire.
